In a slight departure from previous meetings the **RSC Dalton Division** would like to encourage established as well as early career researchers to attend. Priority for oral presentation will of course be given to recent appointees

We would therefore like to invite academics, research fellows and postdoctoral researchers from the UK inorganic chemistry community to attend this three day conference and to submit abstracts for oral presentations.

Conference format

Talks are invited across all aspects of inorganic chemistry from transition metal coordination chemistry, organometallics, main group chemistry, computational chemistry, bioinorganic and solid state materials chemistry.

Additionally, boards will be provided for attendees to present posters for discussion during coffee and lunch intervals.

Location

The conference will be held on the University campus in Huddersfield which is conveniently located adjacent to the town centre and only a few minutes taxi ride or 10 minutes walk from the railway station. Huddersfield is conveniently located in the centre of the UK and is serviced by the regular Trans Pennine train services from Leeds and Manchester by the M62.
